WHAT'S IN OUR CHURCH

It is written in the Old Testament, that Ezra the scribe stood on a wooden platform and read from the scroll to the people. OUR RESPONSE...

*One can only give what one has* - is an old axiom that holds true - for all ages.

If you got \$5.00 you can spend \$5.00. If you "ain't got" 5 bucks, you cannot spend them. Makes sense, right?

In our time, "faking it" is very popular. You just tell others that you have \$5.00, but you don't. And since people are gullible and believe that you do have the money, they are willing to listen what you have to say. This is called lying, cheating, being dishonest,... we know it well.

As you recall, you were baptized and confirmed! Gifts were bestowed upon you so that you would use them to secure your eternal salvation, by persevering in our faith and by defending it and by sharing it. You had these gifts given to you. The thing with spiritual gifts is, that you either use them, or you lose them. It is not like money in your sock under your mattress.

Spiritual gifts are never stagnant - they either increase or decrease. Increasing is always good, since there is no end to it, but when our gifts decrease, there is a point when there is nothing left - and then all is gone.

Do we practice our faith, do we converse with our good LORD, do we bring Christ to others and talk with others about the salvation that is found ONLY in the Catholic Church? See *Fourth Lateran Council of 1215: There is indeed one universal church of the faithful, outside of which nobody at all is saved.* If someone is saved outside the Catholic Church, it is because of the prayers and sacrifices of the one true Church. HOLY ROSARY

Fatima continued:

CODE OF CANON LAW - MARRIAGE 15

Procedure in Danger of Death

**Canon 1068 Unless contrary indications are present, in danger of death, if other means of proof present be obtained it is sufficient that the parties cannot be obtained, it is sufficient that the parties affirm - even under oath, if the case warrants it - that they have been baptized and the they are not held back by any impediment.**

The Code makes one exception to the obligation of conducting a full examination and that is when there is danger of death. Such situations would normally involve persons who are in irregular marriages or living together. Danger of death here means probable danger arising from intrinsic (illness) or extrinsic (war, natural disaster) causes. If it is a question of intrinsic causes, this can be on the part of either or both parties.



The canon presumes that there is no other means of ascertaining freedom to marry except for the statement of the parties themselves. They both must affirm that at least one was baptized and both are free of impediments and other possible invalidating factors. Although the 1917 Code stated that the affirmation was to be given under oath, the present law indicates that this is considered an exceptional way of affirming freedom to marry. Thus the word of the parties would suffice if there were no legitimate reason to doubt their veracity.

This canon may not be used if there is certain knowledge of an impediment or other invalidating factor. This is especially true in cases of people living in unions which are irregular due to a prior marriage on the part of at least one party.

The Obligation of the Faithful To Reveal Impediments

**Canon 1069 - All the faithful are obliged to reveal any impediments they are aware of to the pastor or to the local ordinary before the celebration of marriage.**

The obligation to reveal impediments binds all the faithful and is related to a concern for the common good. It concerns certain or highly probable knowledge of an impediment and not mere suspicion. Family members and other close acquaintances are generally those most significantly affected by this obligation. This obligation includes impediments as well as other invalidating factors, such as serious mental illness or invalidating intentions hidden from the examining priest.

Knowledge obtained in sacramental confession can never be used and in certain cases, knowledge revealed under the auspices of professional confidence or secrecy such as medical or counseling information cannot be revealed. According to certain civil laws, such information can be revealed with the written release of the person involved.



If an impediment is revealed to the pastoral minister, his or her first obligation is to verify it. If indeed a diriment impediment is present, either it must be dispensed by the competent authority or the wedding must be canceled. The course of action taken depends on the nature of the impediment (see c. 1090)
