WHAT'S IN OUR CHURCH

STATIONS OF THE CROSS After the persecutions in the early Church, the emperor Constantine permitted Christians to legally worship Christ. Pilgrims arrived and walked the Via Dolorosa. The Franciscans promoted the Stations, since they were given custody of the Holy Land in 1342. In 1686 Pope Innocent XI allowed the Franciscans to display depictions of the walk of Christ in their Churches. And in 1726 it was allowed in all Churches. The number of stations was fixed to 14; in recent years the Resurrection was added as a 15th station. Consecrated Churches have to have the Stations within their walls. Pope St John Paul II introduced the Scriptural Way of the Cross on Good Friday in 1991 and it was celebrated there until 2020...

THIS IS MY BODY - THIS IS MY BLOOD

If I am a rationalist, a modernist, a communist or an unbeliever, Holy Communion is nothing but a show, a joke and a farce. Jean Jacques Rousseau, was a product of the 18 century Enlightenment. He was an opportunist and a leech of humanity. An example of this: he would father children and then leave them at the doorstep of nuns or churches.

He had the idea that we must go back to our original state of happiness - which can nowhere to be found but in being a "a happy SAVAGE in the woods." He said that modern society has totally messed up people's minds and so they are restrained from all sides and therefore cannot be happy. Let go of restraints, be like a savage - fulfilling your every body's and mind's desire. That was his battle cry. And he became a sought after celebrity who was mooching off rich people who liked to hear these things.

Listen what he said about the holy Mass: "a man in front of old women who eats bread and drinks wine, while they are watching him." One cannot get baser then that!

Corpus Christi - our GOD who has come in the flesh. "Many deceivers have gone out into the world, those who do not acknowledge Jesus Christ as coming in the flesh; such is the deceitful one and the antichrist." (2Jn1:7)

If we could only see the reality of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist we would not dare approach Him, but on our hands and knees, bemoaning our sins and pleading for mercy for our sins. How careless people receive the Body and Blood of Christ at Holy Communion. May we not be found among those who "eat and drink condemnation upon themselves" (1Cor 1:29).

FIVE FIRST SATURDAYS

Why Five Saturdays?

Sister Lucia's confessor questioned her about the reason for the five Saturdays asking why not seven or nine. She answered him in a letter dated June 12, 1930. In it she related about a vision she had of Our Lord while staying in the convent chapel part of the night of the twenty-ninth to the thirtieth of the month of May, 1930. The reasons Our Lord gave were as follows:

The five first Saturdays correspond to the five kinds of offenses and blasphemies committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary. They are:

- a. Blasphemies against the Immaculate Conception.
- b. Blasphemies against her virginity.
- c. Blasphemies against her divine maternity, at the same time the refusal to accept her as the Mother of all men.
- d. Instilling indifference, scorn and even hatred towards this Immaculate Mother in the hearts of children.
- e. Direct insults against Her sacred images.

Let us keep the above reasons firmly in our minds. Devotions have intentions attached to them and knowing them adds merit and weight to the practice.

The Origin of the Feast of Corpus Christi

The first holy Eucharist was confected at the Last Supper, when Jesus spoke and His words changed bread into His Body and wine into His Blood.
