Old Business (FlockNotes)

1. Financial report: Betty Rowley explained the Current Assets. Total cash and investments equal \$480,766. The Total Online Giving was 10,400 for the year 2020. Online Giving is a fairly smooth operation and going pretty well. The Michel's Corp. sent us \$3,000 early in the pandemic and \$4,500 at Christmas, as has been done in the past. The PPP Loan turned into a Loan Forgiveness Grant that will not have to be repaid. Motion to accept the Financial Report made by Gary and Lisa seconded.
2. COVID: Brian cleaned everything including the gum from the pews. For some social distancing is near and dear and others are more neutral. Mass attendance is not too bad, maybe a little less than before COVID. 10-15 per mass on YouTube live, but they are missing out on the Mystical – Body of Christ.
3. Novus Ordo Mass: 10 – 30 people each weekend, some are from outside our parish.
4. Evangelization: 6 -7 people on the team. There is a monthly meeting for discussion.

Catechesis Adult Education: The Baltimore catechism is being used then will go to the Catechism of the Council of Trent.

Bible Study: there are many people attending these two classes, also some watch online.

Book, Luisa Piccarreta: There are 8 volumes.

CCD: is a home study course with 3 children – parents and children are working at home with Fr. Pete's direction.
